



Executive Director of EPC World Outreach

Effective November 1, 2020

1. Summary: The Executive Director of EPC World Outreach will be responsible, in partnership with the World Outreach Committee, to communicate a compelling and specific vision throughout EPC for a strategic investment in bringing the gospel to all the world and to mobilize and equip the EPC to fulfill the commitments, goals and objectives of that vision as outlined in the World Outreach Master Plan.

2. Responsibilities: The Executive Director (in collaboration with the World Outreach Committee) is responsible for the development and implementation of the World Outreach Master Plan to be approved by the General Assembly. Specific responsibilities include:

A. World Outreach Committee (WOC)/General Assembly (GA)

1. Develop and implement the vision, policies, plans, and programs of the WOC as guided by the National Leadership Team.
2. Provide plans and ideas to the WOC to develop the EPC's foreign mission, which includes the budget process.
3. Report regularly to the WOC and annually to the General Assembly on the achievement of stated objectives.
4. Encourage and provide resources to presbyteries and local churches to support world missions. These resources may include people, training, materials, and programs.
5. Develop and implement ministries to internationals in the U.S. as assigned to the WOC by the General Assembly.

B. Servant Leadership

1. Give overall direction and support to the World Outreach Department in the Office of the General Assembly.
2. Lead the World Outreach team (currently the Mobilization Team, Engage 2025, International Theological Education Network, and Member Care) in developing strategies to implement the Master Plan.

C. Member Care

1. Actively exhibit a pastoral heart for World Outreach Missionaries.
2. Ensure the high standards of World Outreach Member Care are effectively provided.



D. Engage 2025 Initiative

1. Champion the Engage 2025 Initiative to presbyteries and churches.
2. Assist presbyteries in identifying and evaluating potential Engage 2025 church planting fields.
3. Monitor, guide, and ensure the ongoing development of the Engage 2025 vision, recognizing the wide variety of implementation strategies employed by presbytery working groups.

E. World Outreach Partnerships

1. Represent the EPC to cooperative agencies, approved mission agencies, and other denominational mission agencies/boards.
2. Network with domestic and foreign mission agencies and denominations.
3. Support or partner with mission endeavors of foreign national churches as directed by the General Assembly.

F. Missiology

1. Be informed about current research and trends in missions worldwide.
2. Inspire and stimulate creative thinking on worldwide missions and ministries to internationals throughout the EPC and the World Outreach mission community.
3. Integrate appropriate methodologies growing out of biblical, theological, and missiological reflection and discussion.

3. Relationships: The Executive Director of EPC World Outreach:

- A. Is selected and called by the National Leadership Team of the General Assembly in consultation with the World Outreach Committee for a three-year term, which is renewable.
- B. Will become a member of an EPC Church or Presbytery. Residency in the Orlando metro area is desirable.
- C. Reports to the Stated Clerk.
- D. Is an ex-officio member of the World Outreach Committee and World Outreach Personnel Committee with voice but not vote.
- E. Supervises the Associate Director, Muslim Field Coordinator, ITEN Coordinator, Member Care Coordinator, IBAM Coordinator, and Missionaries serving under Co-op Agreements.
