FROM THE CHAPLAINS WORK AND CARE COMMITTEE

Recommendation

That the 38th General Assembly revise language for Rules for Assembly X 10-1L.1, increasing the number of committee members.

The Chaplains Work and Care Committee asks for the following revision:

Current Rules for Assembly X 10-1L.1	Proposed Rules for Assembly X 10-1L.1 Additions in <i>bold italics</i>
Membership: The Committee shall consist of six members, including at least three members with experience as Chaplains and at least two Ruling Elders.	Membership: The Committee shall consist of six <i>nine</i> members, including at least three <i>five</i> members with experience as Chaplains and at least two <i>three</i> Ruling Elders. <i>as nominations allow.</i>

Rationale:

Due to the rapidly growing number of chaplains being added to the rosters and the subsequent and significant increase in workload, the number of chaplain contacts for each CWCC member has grown. With this continuing increase and the number of chaplain applicants already in process it was proposed by the CWCC (with the support of the Chaplain Endorser and Assistant Stated Clerk) to increase the Committee membership to nine members.
