Summary of Work, 2020-2021:

1. The Fraternal Relations Committee did not meet in 2020-2021 because the worldwide impact of the COVID-19 Shutdown greatly curtailed the activities of the global church.
2. The Fraternal Relations Committee confirmed that the updated fraternal agreement with the Presbyterian Church of Brazil (IPB) approved by the 40th General Assembly was sent to IPB leadership.


