The Standing Committee on Theology convened at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 19, 2024, and met once. Chairman TE Aaron White opened the meeting with prayer.

B. Recommendations:

1. Recommendation GA44-22: The Permanent Judicial Commission recommends that the 44th General Assembly DECLINE amending the Book of Government sections 8-2 C and Book of Worship 3-3 J and that Recommendation 44-23 be answered by this action be adopted.

2. Recommendation GA44-23: The Presbytery of the Pacific Northwest respectfully OVERTURES the 44th General Assembly APPROVE amending Book of Government 8-2 C and Book of Worship 3-3 J **not be adopted**.

- D. **Recommendation GA44-25:** The Rivers and Lakes Presbytery respectfully OVERTURES the 44th General Assembly APPROVE amending the Book of Worship 3-3 I concerning explicit qualifications for admission to the sacraments of the Lord's Supper **not be adopted**.
