No Action is needed if you are keeping your current coverages.

Creditable Coverage Notice

As an EPC medical plan enrollee you automatically receive a "Creditable Coverage Notice" each October. The Notice is important for those who are Medicare eligible or will become Medicare eligible over the next year and will be enrolling in Medicare or a Medicare Part D prescription drug plan. If you are not in that age category yet, then the notice does not apply to you.
