Are you an ordained Teaching Elder in the EPC?

If you are an ordained Teaching Elder, are you aware of the housing allowance benefit through your EPC Retirement Plan? After turning 59½, you may begin making penalty free withdrawals from your EPC 403(b) (9) retirement account. As an ordained minister, monies drawn from your account used for allowable housing related expenses can be excluded from your income in that year, and will therefore, not be subject to federal income taxes. If you are still receiving a housing allowance from your church, you cannot exceed the annual IRS limits. Did you know that rolling your money out of your EPC 403(b)(9) when you retire or take a different job will cause you to lose this tax exemption?


