Personal Attributes

- Must be a practicing and devoted believer in Jesus Christ who seeks His guidance in all things
- Demonstrates empathy, love, loyalty, and compassion, as well as being patient and understanding when dealing with the congregational members and their concerns
- Continues to grow closer to and understand more about Christ by developing a deeper and more meaningful relationship with God and His people

Theology

- Is thoroughly knowledgeable of the Bible and the power of prayer and lives as an impactful prayer leader
- Serves in agreement with Reformed theology

Preaching and Leadership in Worship

- Responsible for the preaching ministry of the church. Directs the worship staff, office personnel, and congregational members.
- The Pastor's leadership is essential in helping to develop Biblical literacy and spiritual maturity in followers of Jesus Christ.
- Implements a comprehensive program of corporate worship that:
 - Glorifies God
 - Clearly presents Scriptures in accordance with Reformed theology

- Permits and facilitates meaningful participation by the entire congregation
- Encourages the congregation to dig deeply into their faith and to yield to the Holy Spirit and the Word of God in obedience with their faith walk

Pastoral and Ministerial Leadership

- The Moderator of the Session
- Responsible for the leadership and direction of the Church Staff and will be accountable to the Session on behalf of the Staff
- Works cooperatively with the Session and is responsible for the total administration and programs of the church
- Serves as the lead instructor, along with the Session, in overseeing and directing the educational programs of the church
- Assures that all church members receive pastoral care, especially the elderly, widows, the ill, and those in crisis
- Leads the Session in developing and pursuing a clear mission and vision for the Church
- Delegates, monitors, and facilitates appropriate administrative duties, church programs, and financial functions

Education and Experience

- Has an MDiv degree (or the equivalent) from a standard accredited theological seminary
- Is ordained in, or qualified to be ordained by, the Evangelical Presbyterian Church
- It is preferred that he have a minimum of five years of pastoral experience
