#### **Job Summary:**

The Senior Pastor will serve as the lead visionary and spiritual guide for Faith Presbyterian Church. He/she will lead Faith into the future with conviction, vision, and humility and be responsible for supervising the leadership of the church. The ideal candidate will have experience in a leadership position in a church of similar size and be a gifted preacher/teacher able to engage with the community, while fostering a culture of high expectations to help grow God's kingdom.

- Is willing to know the people of FPC and Germantown, and live life together. One who likes people, relationships, and being with others.
- Create a culture of high expectations for every member to develop Godly character and to become disciples of Christ.

- Develop relationships with other churches and organizations in our community consistent with our church's mission
- Manage full and part time staff members, developing annual goals, conducting annual performance reviews, and ensuring staff compliance with church policies and procedures.
