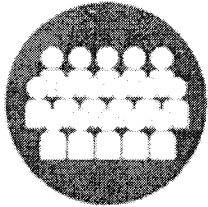


Making followers of Jesus Christ as we gather in worship, grow in community, and go with purpose.

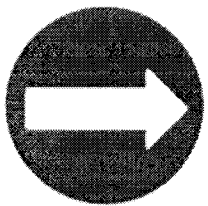
Worship

The Christian life is life together, so on Sundays at FPC we make worship gatherings our priority. Our purpose is to connect with God and each other. Our church strives to create engaging worship experiences where seekers and believers can experience the presence of God and connect with a message that is both relevant and uncompromising.



Grow

The Christian life is an accountable life, so on Sundays and Wednesdays at FPC, we make groups a priority. FPC strives to be a church of (not just with) small groups. A small group is where grace moves from head to heart within the context of high trust and transparency. Our small groups form for a season to build trust, but then reform to reach out.



Serve

The Christian life is shared life. We expect every believer to follow Jesus, including his great commission: "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." (Matthew 28:19-20) We strive to be a church that is outward, sharing faith, hope, and love both practically and personally.
