POSITION SUMMARY

The Pastor of Discipleship at Cornerstone will oversee all adult discipleship strategy, planning, collaboration and execution consistent with the mission and core-values of CEPC. This Pastor will provide clear direction of all adult classes, small groups, and activities which support the mission and core-values of CEPC.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Lead, disciple and supervise key discipleship staff and volunteers
- Preach as invited by the Lead Pastor, in addition to regular presence in the worshipping rhythms of the congregation
- Develop strategies to shape CEPC as a church of small group communities
- Develop strategy to increase congregational engagement in small group ministries
- Develop and maintain a system of support for small group leaders and coaches
- Train small group leaders to pursue a strategy of disciple making that prioritizes CEPC's core values.
- Develop discipling strategy for adult classes.
- Develop discipling strategy for parents and families.
- Regularly report to Lead and Executive Pastor on health and growth of small group ministries
- Invest in church members to develop them into small group leaders and other ministry volunteers
- Integrate discipleship programs across the various departments of CEPC
- Collaborate with other senior leaders to develop ministry that advances the mission, vision and values of CEPC
- Provide pastoral care and counseling when appropriate
- Administrative management of the Discipleship department including budget, volunteer development, etc.
