QUALIFICATIONS: BA or BS Degree, be Ordained or soon to be an Ordained Minister, 1 to 5 years experience in youth or young adult related work and/or activities. Must show evidence of love working with youth.

1. Responsible for the Planning, Developing, Expanding and Implementing the Youth and Adult Christian Education Program of Calvary Presbyterian Church. With emphasis on children, junior high youth, senior high youth, young adults, young couples and young families with children, this Effort includes but is not limited to church school, prayer importance and use, bible studies, specialized learning experiences, discipleship programs and summer developmental programs.
2. Serves as a Teacher, Counselor and Role Model for youth and young adults. Builds and Nurtures relationships by personal example and conduct, discipleship, education, social interaction, fellowship, social activities and sharing life's experiences.
3. Plans and Leads a Church Community Outreach Effort. This includes but is not limited to developing relationships and programs with other churches, local youth ministries, youth related organizations and local charities. Provides mission and service opportunities for youth and young adults. Explores developing a relationship with national youth organizations such as Youth for Christ, Young Life, and Reformed University Fellowship.
4. Assists the Senior Pastor in leading worship, preaching and visitation.
5. Serves as the principal contact with Waterbrook School. Plans and Delivers devotional messages to Waterbrook students. Investigates and Promotes ways for the Church to Initiate and Develop relationships with Waterbrook families.
6. Responsible for the Media Efforts of the Church. This includes Developing and Improving Calvary's online/digital presence. Introduces new literature, relevant movies, library and book table management and other media outreach efforts.
7. Responsible for Expanding and Guiding Calvary Recreational Activities. This includes introducing new recreational opportunities for youth and adults. May include joint recreational activities with neighboring churches.
