Goals of Pineland Church (EPC)

Ministry

Pineland Church will continue its strong history of worship, community service, cooperative teamwork and fellowship, with attention given to an increase in programs and outreach that promote spiritual maturity, understanding of Biblical inerrancy, purity of heart, and a personal commitment to the Great Commission of Christ (Matthew 28:19-20) such that, within 5 years, our membership will have grown by 10%.

Worship

Pineland Church will continue to develop a good music program to engage an atmosphere of spiritual worship that reflects the preaching of God's inerrant Word and engages in practices that build up the Saints for the work of the ministry and for the edifying of the Body of Christ (Ephesians 4:12) such that, within 5 years, our average Sunday morning attendance will increase by 30 individuals.

Pineland Church will, in addition to Sunday morning worship, engage in programs of small Bible study groups, missions groups and fellowship groups that seek to edify the Body of Christ and mature the Saints such that, within 5 years, there will be an additional 3 Bible study groups, 2 missions groups and 2 fellowship groups.

Property

Pineland Church will continue to monitor the condition of its grounds and facilities, with special attention given to specific plumbing and electrical issues, flooring the the fellowship hall, renovations to the gymnasium, and other needs as they arise such that, within the next 5 years, new flooring will be placed in the fellowship hall and the gymnasium renovations will be completed.

Stewardship

Pineland Church will continue to keep the congregation aware of its fiscal expenditures and foster preaching and teaching that encourages the tithing of 1/10th of one's personal resources.
