Position Title: Middle School Youth Director

Start date: July 1, 2018 or sooner

Purpose: To convert and disciple 6th-8th grade students of the church and surrounding area. Bring children participating in the youth group to full church membership. Bringing unchurched parents into church.

Reports to: Pastor bi-weekly, session bi-annually, personnel annually

Hours: 10 hours per week

Pay: \$10 an hour, mileage reimbursement, 2 weeks unpaid vacation

Responsibilities:

1. Weekly worship attendance with possible duties as assigned by Pastor
2. Teach middle school Sunday School
3. Plan & lead weekly after school youth group. Recruit at least 1 adult volunteer from the church for the weekly meeting.
4. Plan & lead two annual retreats. Recruit at least 2 adult volunteers from the church for retreats. There must be at least one adult of each sex at a retreat.
5. Communication with parents, church, & staff about plans 3 months in advance
6. Maintain a social media presence on behalf of the middle school youth group
7. Additional responsibilities as determined by the Pastor or Session
8. Pass a drug test & random tests after employment

Qualifications:

1. Full agreement with the essentials of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church
2. Agreement with the Westminster with exceptions to be approved by session
3. Ability to teach, administrate, and communicate with youth and their families
4. Return communication via phone, text, or email within 24 hours
5. Two years of education or experience with 6-8th graders preferred
6. Valid Drivers License with reliable transportation
7. Clean criminal record with a background check
8. Be at least 20 years of age

Notes:

It is our prayer that the middle school ministry will grow and we will be able to provide a high school ministry as well. If this happens, this position will be offered more hours and pay to expand to Middle and High School Youth Director.

Our church philosophy is to not stop at providing a youth group for the children involved in the ministry. The goal is for children and their families is to become Christians, and grow in discipleship as members of this church. For children who are already part of another Biblical church, we serve as a supplement, encouraging their discipleship.
