PURPOSE

Prepare for pastoral ministry in the area of worship arts through hands-on ministry and mentorship from the pastoral team at Chapel Hill Church.

PRIMARY DUTIES

- Hands-on ministry (75%)
 - Participate weekly in the classic and modern worship teams on an instrument and/or vocal.
 - Serve as backline music director (tracks, on-mic band direction) or up-front worship leader as assigned for services/events.
 - Develop a pipeline of worship musicians across the church, identifying prospective team members to bring on to our Sunday morning teams and bringing them through our on-boarding process.
 - Assist with planning and preparing for worship services that exalt Jesus, elevate others, and launch disciple-makers.
 - Serve in worship leading and music opportunities across the church as assigned, such as memorial services, ministry special events, etc.
 - Participate in meetings during the week surrounding worship services, creative planning, etc.
 - Based on ability/interest, participate in and support seasonal choirs.
 - Support the Pastor of Worship Arts with various needs across the worship arts department.
 - Other duties as assigned.

- Mentorship (25%)
 - Participate in the pastoral residency program and cohort at Chapel Hill.
 - Engage in discussion/mentorship with Pastor of Worship Arts and the pastoral team in the areas of worship arts and pastoral ministry.

- Desire to pursue seminary training preferred

 - Strong up-front worship leading abilities and musical skill (vocals and keys/piano or guitar)
 - Desire to be prepared, trained, and launched as a worship director/pastor
 - Demonstrate a heart for worship, people, and excellence
 - Working knowledge of Planning Center Online or similar tool preferred
 - Willingness to learn new applications, tools, and sites used by department
- Work qualities:
 - Strong administrative, organizational, and time management skills
 - Strong communication and people skills
 - Working knowledge of Microsoft Office suite, email, and calendaring applications
