Teaching for Transformation - We preach, teach and model the gospel of Jesus Christ for transformation of the heart and renewal of the mind.

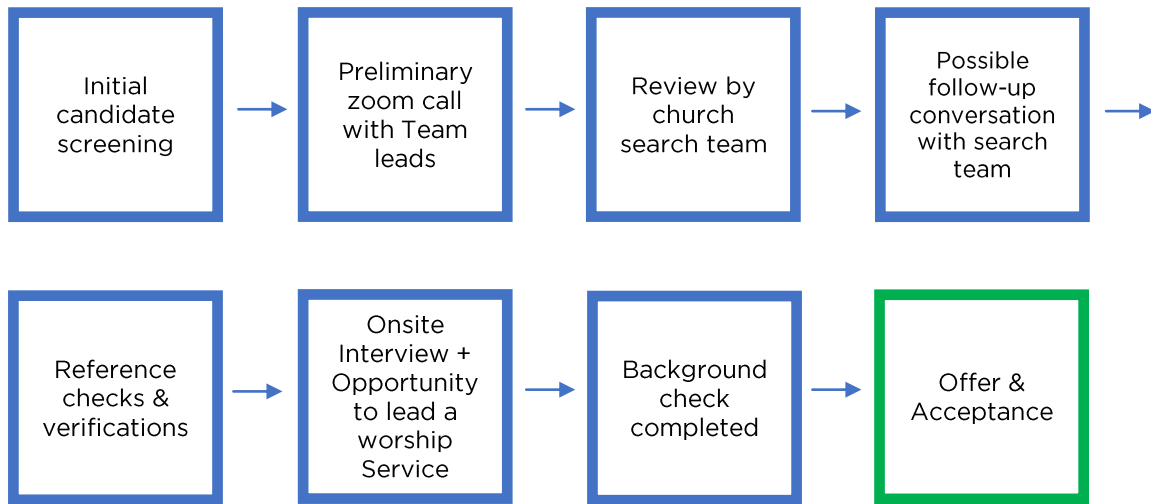
Generation to Generation - We value intergenerational relationships and are an intergenerational church.

- Coordinate the generation of weekly liturgical elements (call to worship/confession)
- Be an example to others by glorifying God (Deut. 6:5, 10:12; Matt. 10:37; Westminster Catechism) and pursuing excellence in corporate worship (1 Chronicles 15:22; 25:6-7; 2 Chronicles 34:12).
