## Requirements for the position of Principalship at Grace Christian School

1. The applicant must hold a master's degree (ideally in education, preferably with an emphasis in administration) from an accredited institution or have principalship on a Louisiana teaching certificate. The principal shall be full time, on-site employee. (The principal may be a teacher as well as the educational administrator of the school.)
2. The applicant must be a mature Christian who has the duty to maintain and uphold the philosophy, mission, values, and goals of the ministry of Grace Presbyterian Church.
3. The applicant must have three to five years' experience in supervisory or management role.
4. The applicant will oversee all aspects of curriculum, educational planning, teaching, spiritual formation, and student life with an emphasis on integrating the mission of GCS with a Christ-centered education.
5. The principal will lead and develop a community of compassionate teachers and staff members who are growing as professionals, work well together, communicate effectively with parents, and are growing in faith and practice.
6. The principal shall monitor school finances and ensure budget compliance.
7. The applicant must undergo both national and state-level criminal background check with the Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information and the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
8. The principal will report to the GCS School Board.
