



Director of Family Discipleship

Job Description

"You then, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others."- 2 Timothy 2: 1-2

Purposes:

- To help foster a culture of Christian discipleship through work with families at GlenHaven and in the surrounding community.
- To help lead children and their families towards a relationship with Christ.
- To increase child involvement/discipleship in the church.
- To be a spiritual support to parents and families of children.

Accountability:

The Director of Family Discipleship is under the supervision of the head pastor.
The Director of Family Discipleship is accountable to session through the pastor.
Program Support – Christian Education Committee.

Requirements

- Have a strong and growing relationship with Christ and a life committed to prayer.
- Have strong interpersonal skills and can communicate the gospel clearly.
- Strong Reformed theological grounding; holds to doctrines consistent with those of the *Evangelical Presbyterian Church*.
- Be reliable and trustworthy; have excellent follow through on commitments and completion of projects.
- Have prior training and/or experience in the church or with children.
- Have a demonstrated passion and commitment to discipleship among children and families.
- Make safety a priority.

Responsibilities

- Works with the Christian Education team to foster and oversee discipleship in children and their families via Sunday School and Wednesday nights.
- Disciple parents to enable them to disciple their children.

- Recruit, train and coordinate workers for Children's Ministry (CM) classes and events, worship services programs. Works cooperatively with all staff and volunteers.
- Coordinate and provide leadership in developing and implementing a young family outreach ministry focused on children activities (ex: Art In The Park).
- Be able to present the Word of God in a clear and age-appropriate manner.
- Develop appropriate tools for involving children in weekly worship.
- Develop activities designed to strengthen the family unit; organize, publicize, and lead these.
- Attend monthly CE Team meetings.
- Participate in the life and worship of the Congregation.
- Become familiar with and implement child protection practices/policies and keep these up to date.

Work Schedule:

20-25hrs, part time (Flex time allowed, consistent with assigned duties).

Salary: \$25,000

Must be available Sunday Mornings and Wednesday Nights.

All official federal holidays off except Veterans and Columbus Day.

1-week paid vacation after 6 months of service.
