- To lead children towards a relationship with Christ.
- To reach our children in the community for the gospel by going "outside the walls."
- To start and partner with the church in building a children's ministry.
- To increase child involvement/discipleship in the church.
- To Be a spiritual support to parents and families of children.

Accountability:

The Children's Director is under the supervision of the head pastor.

The Children's Director is accountable to session through the pastor.

Program Support – Christian Education Committee.

Requirements

- Bachelor's degree is preferred.
- Have a demonstrated spiritual calling to see children come to know Christ and grow in that relationship.
- Have a growing relationship with Christ.
- Know how to have fun!
- Have strong interpersonal skills and can communicate the gospel clearly.
- Must be innovative and in collaboration with the Community Outreach Director and Outreach and Mission Ministry Team in reaching the neighborhood.
- Embrace the teachings and vision of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church.
- Be reliable and trustworthy; have excellent follow through on commitments and completion of projects.
- Have at least two years prior experience working with or organizing children's activities or church programs.
- Have a demonstrated passion for children and families.
- Make safety a priority.

<u>Responsibilities</u>

- Develop and/or select age-appropriate instruction and curricula to disciple children 0-5th grade.
- Recruit, train and coordinate workers for Children's Ministry (CM) classes and events, worship services programs. Works cooperatively with all staff and volunteers.
- Coordinate and provide leadership in developing and implementing a young family outreach ministry focused on children activities in collaboration with the Community Outreach Director.

- Develop and/or select, organize, and lead regular and periodic activities for children of the church and others who may attend like (Game nights, Art In The Park, Backyard, Bible Clubs, etc.)
- Engage children in the surrounding community in the above-mentioned activities and activities specifically designed for community outreach.
- Develop and/or select Sunday School Curriculum in cooperation with the Pastor and Children's/Youth Team. (We are currently using Go Orange).
- Present the Word of God in a clear and age-appropriate manner.
- Develop appropriate tools for involving children in weekly worship.
- Develop activities designed to strengthen the family unit; organize, publicize, and lead these.
- Attend monthly CE Team meetings, weekly Staff meetings.
- Participate in the life and worship of the Congregation, including Sunday mornings.
- Become familiar with and implement child protection practices/policies and keep these up to date.

Work Schedule:

25hrs, part time (Flex time allowed, consistent with assigned duties). Must be available Sunday Mornings and Wednesday Nights. All official federal holidays off except Veterans and Columbus Day. 1-week paid vacation after 4 months of service.
