

Job Description: Director of Worship

Our Mission: To know Jesus Christ, serve him in joyful obedience and make him known by growing disciples, renewing communities and planting churches.

Position Overview: The Director of Worship supports Greentree Church's vision and mission through the creation of engaging worship experiences of diverse and multi-cultural styles, consistent with our intention to love Jesus and love all peoples.

Responsibilities:

- Lead the creative process of designing and directing a holistic worship experience that draws believers into God's presence integrating the value of diverse worship styles, prayer and scripture.
- Regularly participate as worship leader, and whether leading or not, ensure that all worship and events are properly supported by the recruitment, training, rehearsal, and coordination of instrumentalists, vocalists and technical support.
- Engage in and facilitate a collaborative atmosphere in all aspects of worship planning through the strategic implementation of our vision and mission, by creating long and short term worship goals, facilitating staff and volunteer participation through attending meetings, staff functions, and other interaction and designing, creating, purchasing or licensing of worship materials.
- Direct staff and volunteers in implementing multicultural and engaging approaches to scripture, music, (i.e. varied instruments, choirs, hand bells, etc.), storytelling, visual and audio reinforcement all integrated together so that worshipers draw near to God and experience community.
- Ensure that all aspects of GTCC worship; including Sunday mornings, children and youth ministries, weddings, funerals and special events (i.e. Christmas Eve, Good Friday), are resourced and executed in a God glorifying manner.
- Complete other duties that may arise from time to time as our vision and mission become realized.

People / Volunteer Development:

- Identify, develop, lead and disciple a team of staff and volunteers who can design and implement multicultural and diverse worship experiences.
- Develop and lead a worship team of vocalists and instrumentalists who will provide diverse music styles for worship services and special occasions as needed.
- Bring together technical and creative teams supporting worship through the spoken word, audio and visual components, sound and lighting reinforcement and facility design.

Qualification and Skills:

- Growing disciple of the Lord Jesus Christ committed to biblical authority in all areas of life.
- 5-10 years' experience in a successful worship leadership role with demonstrated ability to create an engaging multicultural worship environment that facilitates achieving our vision and mission.
- Strong interpersonal skills; able to build, manage, train and lead cohesive teams.
- Working knowledge of technical functions (audio, sound, lighting, visuals) that support worship.
- Accomplished instrumentalist or vocalist preferred.
- Be a team player. Respect and support staff and ministries with a spirit of humility and love, open to opportunities to assist others with a cheerful heart.
