- Work in close collaboration with Family Ministries Team (Director, Kids Warehouse Coordinator and Student Ministries Coordinator) for collaborative initiatives (i.e. marriage and parenting workshops, spiritual formation events, missional/justice events)
- Spend quality time with students
- Integrate students into the normal, natural life of the church
- Work alongside pastors and elders for shepherding care of community
- Oversee and manage Student Ministry budget
