

Hours: 20 hours per week

Vacation: 3 paid weeks per year

Position Objective: To provide values-driven leadership to the contemporary music ministry of First Presbyterian Church (FPC), a 200 year old, 800 member congregation within the Evangelical Presbyterian Church.

Position Description: Under the supervision of the Senior Pastor, and in cooperation with the Director of Music Ministries and the Worship and Music Committee, the Director of Contemporary Worship will oversee and lead contemporary music at our Fellowship Hall service. FPC Beaver holds services in both our Fellowship Hall and Sanctuary each week. The Sanctuary service is traditional and overseen by the Director of Music Ministries. The Fellowship Hall service is contemporary and is the responsibility of the Director of Contemporary Worship. Our Fellowship Hall service averages around 300 worship attendees each week. This position will require the applicant to serve not only as a musical director, but also as an under-shepherd to the volunteers who serve this ministry.

Qualifications:

- A clear testimony of faith and a vital, growing personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
- A commitment to an authentic witness of integrity in daily living.
- A commitment to the mission, vision, and worship philosophy of FPC.
- Demonstrated excellence as a worship leader and a team player.

Abilities:

- Must possess keyboard and/or guitar skills along with leadership and voice skills to lead worship.
- Must possess relational skills and an enthusiastic presence for leading people in worship.
- Possess vocal and instrumental instruction abilities.
- Must possess organizational and administrative skills and be able to utilize Planning Center as a ministry tool.
- Must be competent in the use of technology in worship and in the use of sound, lighting, and video as well as presentation software such as ProPresenter.
- Must be conversant with digital sound boards, creating excellent sound in the room, and running sound in general.

Responsibilities:

- Maintain an authentic and growing walk with Jesus Christ through the ongoing spiritual disciplines of Bible reading, prayer, personal worship, confession, and fellowship.
- Recruit and train the multi-generational, voluntary contemporary worship team.
- Plan worship services in consultation with the Director of Music Ministries and Senior Pastor, and do so with prayer, conceptual forethought, theological accuracy and musical appropriateness.

- Ensure that all the musical and technical aspects of the service advance the biblical theme for each service.
- Oversee song and media preparation and presentation, sound, and lighting enhancements, and coordination of all instrumentalists and vocalists.
- Direct the rehearsal needed to facilitate music in the contemporary worship services.
- Work with the Director of Music Ministries on combined worship services such as Christmas Eve, Maundy Thursday, and others.
- Provide pastoral care for the worship team.
- Introduce our worship teams to worship training provided by other ministries, books, and conferences.
- Set annual goals for the worship ministry that are in line with church vision and then evaluate how those goals were attained or modified during the year.
