# **Position Responsibilities**

    - Sunday classes from birth through 5th grade during the 9 am Christian Education hour
    - Child care for birth- 4 years old during the 10:15 worship service
    - Special quarterly family events (seasonal activities, Kids Night Out)
    - Kids' Choir
  - Take initiative to enhance and develop Children's Ministry programs and advocate for children in the ministries of GVPC.
  - Maintain an awareness of current topics of concern for growing families in the world today. Take advantage of continuing education and learning opportunities in order to guide and shepherd families.

# Volunteer Management

- Actively participate in the recruitment, training, and organization of volunteers.
- Ensure that all children's ministry activities are adequately staffed and provide help where needed.
- Ensure that all volunteers comply with the Child Protection Policy of Great Valley Presbyterian Church.
