I. Position Summary

II. Position Requirements

<u>Education/Experience</u>: college graduate; MDiv seminary degree; willingness to be ordained in ECO (or similar presbytery); previous experience working in a ministry with middle/high school or university students.

<u>Knowledge</u>: Understanding and belief of Biblical and reformed theology; knowledge of ministry to middle and high school students; well informed about the current teen culture and issues they are facing.

<u>Skills</u>: Strong leader; team player; relational; gifted teacher and communicator to students and their parents; ability to build positive relationships with children, teens, college and graduate students (and their families); management/budget/computer/organizational skills; ability to develop and implement a strategic, sustainable plan and ministry

<u>Resources and Training Provided</u>: Time and budget for continuing educational opportunities and training.

III. Description and Responsibilities

- 1. Reports directly to session and senior pastor.
- 2. Ensure that child protection policies and procedures are in place and being followed by student ministry volunteers and staff. Ensure all weekly student ministry volunteers have completed an application and receive training prior to serving in the student ministry. Ensure all volunteers are receiving ongoing training and support. Recruit all weekly student ministry volunteers (in a timely manner. Meet personally with each student ministry volunteer.
- 3. Establish and maintain a systematic student ministry program that engages a growing number of elementary, middle and high school students each week.
- 4. Plan and promote all major events and weekly programming.
- 5. Pray for and personally contact inactive students and their parents.
- 6. Be visible at non-CPC student events during the school year and invite a volunteer to accompany you on those visits. Be visible and present in lives of students and their activities.
- 7. Create and update plans for each major event. Keep staff informed of activities, events and budget.
- 8. Create, maintain and distribute control documents (student directory, student ministry calendar, calendar requests, event and trip registration forms, leader directory, 1st timer directory, etc.)
