Mingo church is governed by a session of 7 Elders and is part of the Rivers of Life Presbytery, ECO. Our church consist of 72 covenant partners with an average attendance of 60 for worship on Sundays post pandemic.

Church property has had recent updates that include an additional room to the church parlor with library, fellowship hall expansion, all new HVAC, new roofs, newly asphalted double parking lot with new culvert installed, and sanctuary updates including a total floor restoration.

*In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, we provided consistent spiritual material via e-mail, made regular telephone contact with our congregation, and updated our technology to hold parking lot worship services. We have returned to in-person worship services in an environment emphasizing safety and currently provide a video of the weekly sermon on our website.

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The Pastor will be responsible for the structure, order, and content of all worship services. The Pastor will provide for biblically-based worship, selecting the Scripture lessons to be read, preparing and preaching the sermons, leading the prayers offered on behalf of the people, and choosing the music to be sung. The Pastor will encourage the people to participate fully and regularly in worship as well as provide home and hospital visitation to the ill and needy, moderate session, celebrate the sacraments, and provide spiritual leadership and pastoral care for the congregation. The Pastor's role is not limited to these duties, with any further duties to be determined jointly by the Pastor and the Session.

Accountability: The Pastor will be accountable first of all to God, and then to the Session and to the presbytery.

COMPENSATION/HOUSING:

Salary with benefits based on ECO guidelines. Includes four bedroom Manse (located on church property) with full bath and detached garage. Recent updates: New roof, windows, and newly painted. Amenities include covered front porch with swing, private back yard deck, and gas fireplace.
